

Create User in Terminal

Set the username and password

```
dscl . -passwd /Users/<username> <password>
```

Set the user's default shell

```
dscl . -create /Users/<username> UserShell /bin/bash
```

Set the user's display name

```
dscl . -create /Users/<username> RealName "Real Name"
```

Set the user's primary group

```
dscl . -create /Users/<username> PrimaryGroupID 1000
```

Set the user's home directory

```
dscl . -create /Users/<username> NFSHomeDirectory /Users/<username>
```

Promote user to local admin

```
dscl . -append /Groups/admin GroupMembership <username>
```

Set the user's ID

```
dscl . -create /Users/<username> UniqueID 510
```
