

Get GUID of installed program and remove it

Powershell:

Find GUID of program to uninstall.

```
get-wmiobject Win32_Product | Sort-Object -Property Name | Format-Table IdentifyingNumber, Name, LocalPackage -AutoSize
```

Uninstall a program using MsiExec - quietly

```
msiexec.exe /x "{588A9A11-1E20-4B91-8817-2D36ACBBBF9F}" /q
```
